PHYSICAL CHARACTERISTICS

Canopy potential: 12' – 15' wide

Annual Growth Rate: 24"

Powerline Friendly: 15' – 20' from base

Root Damage Potential: Low

Leaves: Silver-Gray.

Flowers: Sulfur-Yellow.

Tree Care: Plant in full sun. Tolerant in alkaline soils. Water once every two weeks during the Summer. Frequent irrigation promotes growth. Little pruning is needed except to shape and to raise the crown.

Ecosystem Services: Used by the indigenous people of Australia for medicine, food and everyday items; can treat skin ailments, flu, coughs, colds, and warts; is used as firewood, as material to make shelters, weapons and implements.
